



MFL Revision: Guide for Parents

Exams: Each skill represents 25% of the exam grade.

Topics examined in each exam: Self, family and friends, leisure time, celebrations, town, holidays, school, world of work and future plans, global/environmental issues.

Speaking exam (w/b 7th May), listening, reading and writing exams (w/b 14th May).

Exam	Revision requirements	Revision materials already provided for students.	Other revision resources
Speaking	Role-play Photo based discussion Conversation topics (Represents <u>half the marks</u> on this element of the exam). Students choose 1 topic and prepare a 1 minute presentation followed by questions. They must revise all the other topic areas (listed above) as then one more topic will be tested.	Sheet stuck into exercise books containing key phrases to revise. Hand-out given with practice role-play and photo based questions which can be used to revise (uploaded onto My USO.) Answers to questions on each topic area already prepared and students should have a copy of these in their books.	BBC Bitesize Edexcel 9-1 revision guide and workbook. www.voki.com (creates an avatar and check pronunciation). memoRISE app can support learning of presentations.

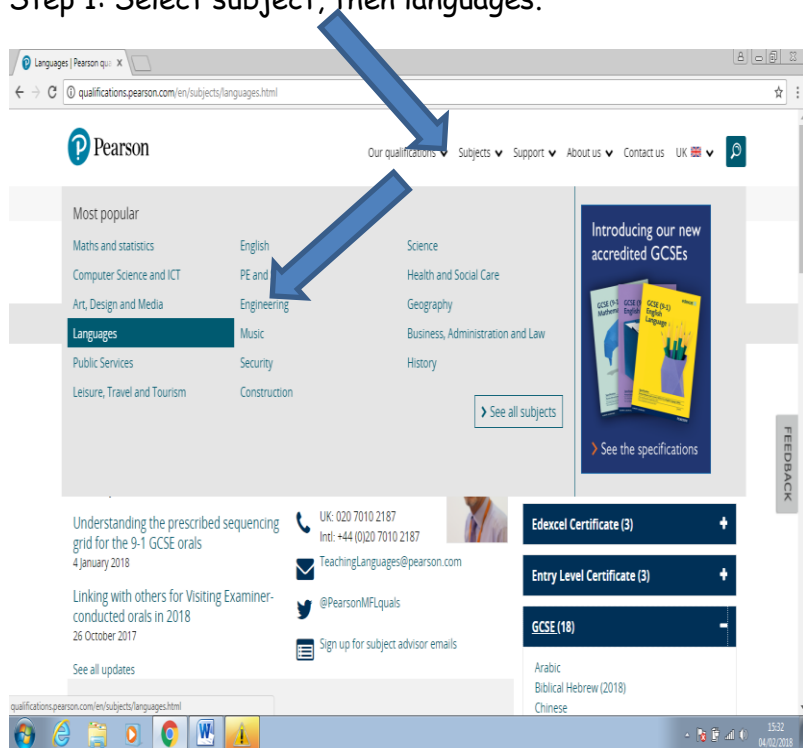


Writing	Revision of all topic areas. Key verbs in different tenses (see recycled language sheet), linking words and opinions. As a revision approach, students could prepare 100 words on each topic from the end of module questions in their exercise books. They should include opinions and reasons, past and future tense. Grade 5+ should also learn 5 higher level structures that they could use on any question (sheet stuck in books).	End of module questions (as mentioned above) in exercise books. Question booklet given to every student. Translation booklet given to every student (uploaded to My USO).	BBC Bitesize Edexcel 9-1 workbook for writing only.
Reading	Learning vocabulary (best approach is 10 minutes on a regular basis). Practice questions.	Specification contains full list of vocabulary requirements (uploaded onto My USO). 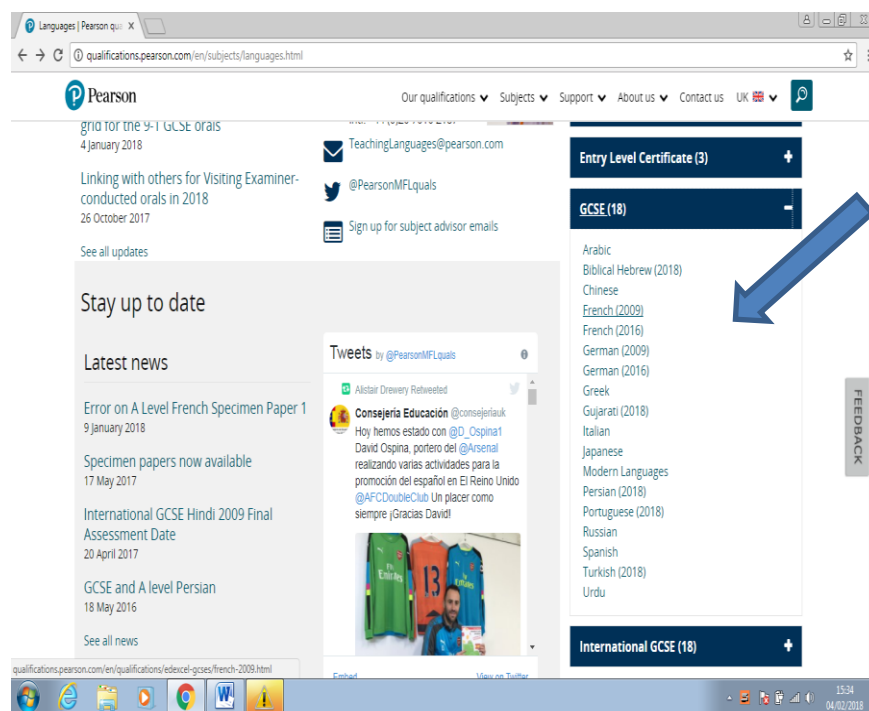
Step 1: Select subject, then languages.
