

### Year 10 Wider Return to College.

<u>Concern</u>	<u>Expectation</u>
Group sizes on return.	<p>We will be welcoming no more than 6 students at one time to form part of focus groups in College. Student will be expected to maintain social distancing guidelines at all times in College which stands at 2 metres.</p> <p>Each group will be given staggered start times to ensure that we have minimum numbers in and around the College building at one time, Students must not arrive earlier than their start time.</p>
Entering the College building.	<p>Students are advised to avoid walking to College with others. Year 10 students will enter the building via the East or West staircase doors. They will enter the doors based on what classroom they will be escorted to.</p> <p>Students will meet a member of staff at the door and students must adhere to government guidance of 2 metres from other students when in line.</p> <p>Students will be asked to use anti-bacterial gel before entering the College building.</p> <p>Students will be escorted to and from their classroom by a teacher at all times. They will also leave the College at staggered intervals. Students are expected to leave sensibly.</p>
Classroom expectations	<p>Classrooms have been adapted to hold six individual tables, spaced out to adhere to the 2 metre guideline. Students will be expected to enter the classroom and remain seated at the table during the group session.</p> <p>Students are to place their bag(s) under their desk and their coat on the backs of their chairs.</p> <p>Students can use the college toilets one at a time if and when necessary.</p>
Moving around the College	<p>Students must stay 2 metres apart.</p> <p>We ask that students do not touch door handles at any time. College lockers <b>WILL NOT</b> be in use for students. Students must not go to their lockers when in college.</p> <p>Students are expected to act responsibly around College and respect other student's personal space without silly behaviour.</p> <p>Students must not access the Heart.</p>
Dropping off/collecting students	<p>We ask that students are dropped off/collected in the Car Park safely, in accordance with government guidelines – please do not drive up to the small car park by the College doors. Students should walk into College alone and not with friends.</p>
Food/Drink in College	<p>Students will not access the canteen when in College – students may bring a bottle of water but we ask that students do not bring food onto college premises.</p>

We ask that students adhere to the guidelines above and ensure that they follow them respectfully. We will continue to work alongside parents/carers for any student not doing this in order to safeguard everyone within our care.
