WHAT SENIOR ROLES ARE THERE?

there are 4 main areas of senior student leadership at HTCS. these are:

- **HEAD BOY, HEAD GIRL, AND DEPUTIES**
- **HEAD BOY, HEAD GIRL AND DEPUTIES OF EACH OF OUR 4 HOUSES**
- **SENIOR PREFECTS (APPROXIMATELY 4 PER HOUSE)**
- **WHOLE-SCHOOL PREFECTS**

THE PROCESS OF APPOINTMENTS

The dates may vary each year but the process and time frames for each senior role can be seen below:

Head Boy, Head Girl and Deputies

- **TIMEFRAME** – Begins and ends during Half Term 3 and 4 between the New Year and Easter
- **WHAT IS INVOLVED** – Applications, interviews with AHT, YL, SSO and current HBHG, campaigns/presentations and election by staff.

Head Boy, Head Girl and Deputies for each House

- **TIMEFRAME** – Begins post Easter in Term 5. Any unsuccessful HBHG candidates can then re-apply for these verbally
- **WHAT IS INVOLVED** – Applications and Interviews by HoH and current HBHG of each House

Senior Prefects and Community Prefects

- **TIMEFRAME** – Begins post Easter in Term 5.
- **WHAT IS INVOLVED** – Applications and Interviews by HoH. Any unsuccessful prefects may be nominated for Community Prefect working whole school

WHAT ROLES DO THE DIFFERENT SENIOR STUDENTS TAKE ON?

Head Boy, Head Girl and Deputies

- Act as role models for the whole College
- Act the face for HTCS at major events such as Open Evening and Awards Evening as well as being the face of HTCS for the media
- Lead the College Council & join the Governing Body at HTCS
- Meet and Greet special guests
- Lead student panels and tours for interviews
- Enact their manifestos

Head Boy, Head Girl and Deputies of Houses

- Act as role models for their House
- Act the face for their House at major events such as Open Evening, Awards Evening, House Assemblies and events
- Lead the House Council & join the College Council on occasion
- Take part in student panels and tours for interviews
- Enact their manifestos for their Houses
- Lead their Houses in House Competitions and events

Senior Prefects and Community Prefects

- Both roles – Act as role models for their House/Year
- Both roles – Act the face of the College at events such as Open Evening, Awards Evening and lead tours etc.
- Both Roles – Take part in student panels and tours for interviews
- Both Roles – Support with duties around college
- Senior Prefect – Support Houses in House Competitions and events
- Senior Prefect – Lead/take part in Year Councils or take part in House Councils
- Community prefects – see above, but also lead teams looking at specific Whole-College priorities i.e. Mental Health etc.
